The White Lake Police Foundation is accepting applications for the inaugural Scholarship Program. The deadline for applications is May 3, 2024. The scholarship(s) grants up to \$5,000 per year. A minimum of 2 and a maximum of 5 applicants will receive between \$1,000 - \$2,500 as a one-time installment.

### Scholarship Program Purpose:

**Eligibility:** Only High School Seniors are eligible to apply and must be a White Lake Resident.

**Requirements:** Scholarship recipients will be required to attend school full-time.

**How to apply:** Students wishing to be considered must complete an application form and submit it to the White Lake Police Foundation.
